Children's Hospital Boston is a medical United Nations, a potpourri of families from more than 100 countries. Many are unfamiliar with the United States, unable to communicate in English, alone and afraid. To get here, they travel a long and emotional road. Fortunately, our International Center guides them on their journey, from the first phone call to their return home.

Services provided to families:

- Interpreter assistance at each appointment in more than 35 languages
- Arrangement of consultations, medical records transfer and appointment scheduling
- Liaison service between the child's home doctor and Children's doctors
- Financial consultation, including estimates of medical costs and anticipated living expenses
- Assistance with travel arrangements, including visa applications, U.S. immigration and customs

Some recent highlights:

MR/OR

This surgical imaging suite, the first in the U.S. at a pediatric hospital, captures digital images through a unique, ceiling-mounted, movable MRI scanner that can be used to take high-resolution, real-time patient scans before, during and after a surgical procedure.

Robotic Surgery

Children's was the first pediatric hospital in the United States to use high-tech robots in our quest for less invasive surgery and a new level of precision. Children's specially-trained surgeons have developed new and expanded uses for the robot, and also use one to train surgeons from around the world on its use.

Fetal Heart Surgery

In 2001, Children's doctors completed the first successful fetal heart surgery in United States history. Since then, they have performed more than 100 of these procedures with increasing success, establishing Children's as one of the preeminent hospitals in the world for fetal heart surgeries.
